The TriCounty Community Network (TCN) is an organization that encourages partnerships among business and community members in southern Berks, northern Chester and western Montgomery Counties. Our mission is to build relationships among organizations, community members and businesses through advocacy, information sharing and education to improve health, social and environmental conditions within the TriCounty area.

Our purpose is to coordinate human services, offer assistance in solving identified community concerns and to improve services to those in need. To accomplish this purpose, TCN networks to improve services, engages in community planning through education, advocates for constructive change at all levels and functions as a clearing house for and exchange of information and resources concerning health, social and environmental issues.

TCN provides a free, confidential information and referral service known as **FirstCall**. Callers are provided information and referred to community agencies that provide the services, benefits and answers they need. **FirstCall** is funded by the United Way of Western Montgomery County.
