4. The language of Conquest has captivated the church, beginning with Constantine. Where do you see this language woven into the gospel of Jesus' kingdom?
5. How does this language hurt the revolutionary cause of Jesus' new humanity?
6. How has the Church lost its identity today, and what might the baptism of a new birth mean to us? (See pg 165–183)
